Dear Members of the House Committee on Energy and Commerce,

Ahead of the Committee's first hearing with U.S. Department of Health and Human Services (HHS) Secretary Alex Azar, I write on behalf of Equity Forward to highlight issues of concern that we feel HHS has failed to adequately address. As a 501(c)(3), nonpartisan watchdog project, Equity Forwardⁱ seeks to ensure transparency and accountability among anti-reproductive health groups and individuals who are actively working to deny people access to services.

Of particular concern are the abuses and mismanagement of resources by the Office of Refugee Resettlement (ORR) under the direction of Scott Lloyd. Director Lloydⁱⁱ, a career political activist with no relevant experience running an aid- or refugee-focused organizationⁱⁱⁱ, has consistently overstepped his authority and imposed his personal beliefs on a vulnerable population. His well-documented efforts^{iv} to prevent women in his agency's care from exercising their right to access abortion care is not just troubling, it is unconstitutional, and the federal courts have agreed^v. It was also recently revealed that Director Lloyd inquired about having a young woman in his care undergo an experimental, unproven "abortion reversal" treatment^{vi}. As of yet, Secretary Azar has not discussed Lloyd's actions under oath or even publicly.

We have several questions for Secretary Azar on his management of ORR and Director Lloyd, including:

- Do you agree with Director Lloyd's actions in the cases of pregnant, undocumented minors?
- Will you commit to sharing how much of the public's money was spent by HHS in support of or in defense of Director Lloyd's privately-held beliefs? Expenses should include, but are not limited to travel costs^{vii}, Department of Justice^{viii} and HHS legal fees, and staff time to implement and defend Director Lloyd's actions.
- We know from records that have been made public that Director Lloyd inquired about having a young woman in his care undergo an "abortion reversal" treatment. Do you condone your agency directors pursuing experimental, unproven medical treatments that have been rejected as not credible by the medical community^{ix}?
- Do you have confidence in Director Lloyd and will you let him continue to serve on your team?

I thank you for your time and consideration. Enclosed please find additional background and documentation of the aforementioned issues. Please do not hesitate to reach out to discuss any of these issues further.
